Product: Anti-Fas-FITC mAb, clone 3.22

Background:

Activation of either the 55 kDa tumor necrosis factor receptor (TNF-R1) or CD95 (Fas/Apo-1) causes apoptosis of cells and liver failure in mice, and has been associated with human liver disorders.

Ig Isotype:

Mouse IgG_{1/k}

Species Reactivity:

Human. Others not tested.

Format:

1.0 mL of FITC-labeled monoclonal antibody in PBS, 0.08% sodium azide and protein stabilizer.

Storage:

Store at 4°C. Do not freeze.

Applications and Suggested Dilutions:

Monitoring of activated T cells in peripheral blood; Analysis of NK subsets; Study of B cell activation.

- Flow cytometry
- Immunofluorescence

PBMC: Add 10 µL of mAb/10⁶ PBMC in 100 µL PBS. Mix gently and incubate for 15 minutes at 4°C. Wash twice with PBS and analyze or fix with 0.5% v/v of paraformaldehyde in PBS and analyze.

Whole Blood: Add 10 µL of mAb/100 µL of whole blood. Mix gently and incubate for 15 minutes at room temperature (RT). Lyse the whole blood. Wash once with PBS and analyze or fix with 0.5% v/v of paraformaldehyde in PBS and analyze. See instrument manufacturer's instructions for lysed whole blood and immunofluorescence analysis with a flow cytometer or microscope.

The optimal dilution for a specific application should be determined by the researcher.

For *in vitro* research use only. Not for use in diagnostics or in humans.
